Panasonic nanoe<sup>TM</sup> X technology offers the benefits of hydroxyl radicals (also known as OH radicals) contained in water and has the capacity to inhibit bacteria, viruses, and other pollutants as well as deodorise odours. The nano-sized particles of nanoe<sup>TM</sup> X allow for deep penetration into soft furnishings like fabric, sofas, and carpets. nanoe<sup>TM</sup> technology is proven to effectively inhibit more than 99%\* of novel coronavirus.
