### When using the "Panasonic SmartApp+" app

(Cause of malfunction due to radio waves from the appliance)

- Keep at least 15 cm away from the mounting part of the cardiac pacemaker.
- Keep away from medical equipment and automatic control equipment (automatic doors, fire alarms, etc.).

• "Water Save" is the recommended program for a normally soiled load at rated capacity of this washing machine for use in Singapore.

# **Detergent / Softener / Bleach**

- Follow the instructions on each package.
- For cleaning (P. 22)
- Close Auto Dose tank completely before use. Push the tank until there is a "click" sound.



#### For manual dosing

#### **Detergent**, Bleach



e.g.) Liquid bleach



- Do not pour detergent directly into the tub.
- The level of foaming depends on the load size, soil, detergent, and water hardness.
- Dilute bleach with water before putting it in the detergent/bleach inlet.
- Pour detergent according to water level, follow the instructions on the package.

# Auto Dose

Detergent and softener will be automatically added depending on the amount of laundry and dose amount setting, available with all programs except "Tub Hygiene", "Air Dry (90 min)" and "Water Save" (Softener only). (P. 35)

# Washing Options (continued)

#### Stain Master +

#### Preparation: (P. 7)



#### Air Dry (90 min)

The air blown from the tub rotation removes water from clothes.

 Dryable clothes: Synthetic fibre (Max. 3.0 kg)



#### (NOTE)

- Clothes may not be sufficiently dried (depends on amount and type of clothes, and the temperature).
- This function does not use a heater. Clothes may be cold and half dry.

### ECONAVI

• "Normal" program only Weight / Temperature Water and time



#### Lamp indications



#### To turn on/off



- \* Test conditions:
  - "Normal" program
  - Comparison between ECONAVI-enabled operation (amount of laundry: 2.0 kg, water temperature: above 35 °C) and ECONAVIdisabled operation (amount of laundry: 16.5 kg (rated capacity), water temperature: below 15 °C)
  - Test was conducted based on IEC60456 except for water temperature.

- Alternatively, you can search for the "Panasonic SmartApp+" app on Google Play (Android) or App Store (iOS) and install the app.
- You can also scan the link to install the app from the QR code pasted on the washing machine.
- 2 Follow instructions displayed on the screen of the app and register the washing machine.
  - Operate in a position where you can check the display on the washing machine.
  - It cannot be operated while the washing machine is running.



### Using the "Panasonic SmartApp+"

After initial setting is completed, you can use the app.



### NOTE

- To cancel the remote control mode  $\rightarrow$  turn the power off.
- When there is no remote control from the app, the remote control mode is released after 23 hours. During remote control mode, all buttons on the appliance (except ) are disabled. You can only control the washing machine from the app. After 23 hours, the normal screen is displayed and the remote control is disable.



# Panasonic SmartApp+ (continued)

### Initializing

Reset the wireless LAN settings to the default settings. (Operate on the washing machine) You should also stop using the service of the app.

- When you stop using the "Panasonic SmartApp+"
- Suspected use due to unauthorized access
- If the appliance is a pre-owned machine



Reset all the contents such as the wireless LAN settings, washing machine settings, operation history, etc. to the state at the time of purchase.

### Error Display

Error display	Causes & Measures
U81	<ul> <li>Failed to connect the washing machine and the wireless LAN router. Check the following.</li> <li>The router is not turned on. → Turn on the power.</li> <li>The distance between the router and the washing machine is too long.→ Bring the router closer.</li> <li>There is a device that uses radio waves, such as a microwave oven, nearby.</li> <li>→Keep a distance.</li> <li>→Stop using the device or wait a while and try again.</li> <li>Multiple devices are connected to the router.</li> <li>→Turn off the power of the device you are not using.</li> </ul>
U82	<ul> <li>Communication error with the server.</li> <li>There may be a problem with your internet connection.</li> <li>→ If you do not know the cause, contact your provider, carrier, or router manufacturer.</li> </ul>
U83	<ul> <li>In "Backup connection", SSID or password of the router is incorrect.</li> <li>→ Check the description of the router.</li> <li>Failed to connect the washing machine and the router.</li> <li>→ Check the above "U81".</li> </ul>
U84	<ul> <li>"Scan connection" failed.
